## School Admissions for 2014/15

Devon's application facility for Primary School places in September 2014 is now open and will close at midnight on 15th January 2014. Children born between **1/9/2009** and **31/8/2010** will require Primary School places from September 2013, although parents may defer entry, they must apply by 15th January 2014 to be considered for a place.

Start dates can be discussed with Schools once offers have been made. Late applications will not be considered above timely ones where schools are oversubscribed. **Please apply on time!** Details of the school offered will be sent by email on the morning of 16th April, 2014, followed by a hard copy letter, sent 2nd class post.

There is a single offer point of September, but parents can defer or delay. Devon's admissions team will offer all places on **15th April** for a September start. Parents can negotiate start dates direct with the school later in the process, if a delay is desired.

Devon are striving to reduce the number of late applications and the consequent distress to parents and children when they aren't offered their local school, or the school their siblings already attend.

Statutory school age, your child must be in full-time education by the start of the term following their fifth birthday, but this does not mean that they have to be in education before then. As parents when you are offered a place for September you have the following options:

1. Full-time admission to Reception,
2. Part-time admission to Reception up to the statutory school age,
3. Part-time attendance at Grafton Childcare or another pre-school setting while deferring a place in Reception.

But you cannot take a part-time place in Reception and free Early Years Entitlement Funded place at Grafton Childcare or another pre-school setting. Neither can you take a free full-time Early Years Entitlement Funded place at Grafton Childcare or another pre-school setting, although you could arrange for additional pre-school hours but would have to pay for them.

As a parent, you have the right to defer your child's admission until statutory school age, at the beginning of the term following their fifth birthday, even though you will have been offered a place for the previous September. This is a decision for you as a parent to make. We would advise you to take all factors into account including advice of the head of the Early Years Foundation Stage at the school and the Head of Grafton Childcare, Denise Tupman.

Not all four year olds will have reached the required levels of self-confidence, self-esteem self-care and emotional development to attend full-time school from September, this is why Devon previously offered a Two Point entry system of September and January!

If you wish to defer admission, you must inform the school which has been allocated. **That place will be held open up to the start of the term after your child's fifth birthday within that academic year by the school, and will not be offered to another child.** However you must inform the school in writing of your intention to do so, otherwise your child's place may be withdrawn and offered to another child.

<b>Child's fifth birthday</b>	<b>Can defer until</b>
1 September - 31 December	January
1 January - 31 March	January OR April, the start of the Summer Term
1 April - 31 August	January OR April OR the next September with a fresh application for a Year 1 place.

We hope that we have explained the admissions process and things are a little clearer for you all. However if they are not or if you would like to discuss in more detail whether or not it might be in the best interests to defer the entry of your particular child into full-time education particularly for those whose birthdays fall between the 1st January and the 31st August, either drop Denise an email or pop a note into your child's Daily

He will have his very own scrapbook for you to help your child complete during his visit. It would be lovely if you could support your child with this and possibly take a couple of photos and stick them into Grafton's scrapbook to help him to remember what you have all been up to and possibly write a little bit about his adventures at your home. We are very happy for those who do not have access to a printer, for you to email us a couple of pictures and a short article for us to print out and pop into Grafton's scrapbook to help your child to share their adventures.

### Gates, Bags Daily Diaries and Communication Books

Can we please gently remind parents and carers that the rear double gates are open each morning between 7.00 am - 9.30 am and then each afternoon between 4.00 pm - 7.00 pm. All children must be dropped off at the rear conservatory door between those times, with their Bag containing changes of clothes, Calpol, nappies and their Daily Diary or Communication Booklet. If they do not have these then sadly they and their child will be turned away at the doors. We will not tolerate any parent verbally abusing our staff at the door because they have forgotten these items. If you arrive between 9.30 am and 4.00 pm when the rear double gates are closed, please walk around to the front door of number 24 Torquay Road and ring the bell and we will let you in. When using the front door please remember to face the door bell as it contains a very small camera. If we cannot see your face we will ask who is at the door. If you do not respond we will **NOT** open the door. Please do not repeatedly ring the front doorbell it is very loud and although you cannot hear it, it is positioned inside the premises where the staff can. The staff are not permitted to allow children to enter via the rear gates once they have been closed at 9.30 am, please respect this and do not ask staff to do so. Please remember these measures are simply for the safety and security of your children, so that we can keep them all safe & sound & secure.

## New Toys & Resources

Since our last newsletter we have been busy adding new equipment, resources and consumables for the staff and children to use here at Grafton.

We have purchased some new large purple dustbins for storing some of our resources which the children access outside, to protect them from the elements.

Each of the over 2's, 3's and 4's have been given a large purple exercise book in which we shall be encouraging them to do their gluing and sticking and any "phonics or mathematics work" they may want to do around our topics. But it will be up to the children to decide as and when they would like to add to their Books.

We have just ordered a new batch of 1000 observation stickers, which we complete and stick into the children's Learning Journals, we can't believe we have used up the last batch of a 1000 so quickly.

We have a new Big Book Stand, which is very handy during our literacy, phonics and mathematics sessions so we can pop our large books onto it so that all of the children can clearly see and follow along with the activities.

100 Wooden Stars and Tree shapes which the children are very industriously turning into the most beautiful decorations to add to your Christmas trees, we hope you love them as much as the children have enjoyed making them.

A set of purple neck lanyards for the staff to wear in the new year ..... watch this space for more details.

A new cosy corner cushion for the under 2's to crash out on of an afternoon should they need 40 winks.

A kilo of green glitter, 2 dozen glue sticks and other craft items from Crafty Crocodile.

Two new pop up tents one for the under 2's and an amazing VW Camper version for the over 2's, a new Wooden Small World Play Double Decker Bus for the under 2's and a new Wooden Till and Scales for the over 2's, which came in very handy for their Baker's Shop recently.

A new collection of clip art from Thistle Girl Designs, we hope you enjoy them they are just what we needed to spice up our newsletters and our weekly planning sheets.

A new set of cookie stampers for the under 3's to use when they are making cookies, we are looking forward to making lots more scrummy cookies during 2014, we hope you enjoyed the ones they made for Children in Need.



Diary and we will make an appointment to discuss your child's admissions arrangements more fully.

But either way please remember you must apply for a place as normal online at [www.devon.gov.uk/admissionsonline](http://www.devon.gov.uk/admissionsonline) or on the Devon Common Application Form by the deadline of 15 January 2014. Remember Places will be offered to start in September but parents may wish to defer until the term of the child's 5th birthday.

Remember no decision about this is needed at the time of application. But not applying in time can severely disadvantage applicants for oversubscribed and popular schools.

## Grafton Childcare - Early Years & Childcare Registers

When Grafton Childcare first opened in 1991 we cared for just three children each day, how things have changed as we now provide Early Years Childcare for almost 40 children under 5 years of age every day 50 weeks a year and have a very healthy waiting list for places next year. We would like to thank all of our wonderful parents, children and of course our amazing team of staff for this astounding success story.

Grafton Childcare has been registered to provide childcare since 1st July 1991 when Denise originally registered as a Registered Childminder and slowly took on a number of Registered Assistants as Grafton expanded and her young sons started schools themselves. Then on the 2nd September 2008 Grafton Childcare expanded again and became Childcare on Domestic Premises when operating with four or more staff and remaining as Childminders when operating with less than 4 staff. This has worked really well for the past five years, but has meant that we have been required to duplicate an awful lot of paperwork at times which was very time consuming.

The Early Years Register covers children up till their 5th birthday and the Childcare Register covers children from five years of age up until their 8th birthday. We have provided wrap-around childcare for children between five and eight years of age for over 22 years. However the childcare market has changed massively in the past five years with most local Primary Schools now offering some form of either breakfast and after school clubs and/or holiday clubs.

These clubs are highly subsidised having no rent or business rates to pay unlike a private setting like Grafton Childcare, they also run at much higher child to adult ratios than Grafton Childcare, which means that their fees are significantly



lower than our all inclusive rates of £4.10 per hour. The upshot being that Denise was providing wrap-around childcare for only one or two children each day and a similar number during school holidays, which was simply no longer sustainable. In October we took the long hard decision to resign from the Childcare Register and October half-term was the last time we operated our Holiday provision for 5 - 8 year olds, it was a bit of an end of an era.

On the 3rd February 2014 Denise also intends to resign her registration as a Childminder as well. The main effect this will have is that we will no longer be able to offer overnight childcare or any home based babysitting services to parents even if these were done previously for free! However as only two families have used this facility in the past two years the escalating public liability costs to offer this underused service also sadly make it no longer sustainable.

Grafton Childcare has grown massively in the past 22 years and we shall now be concentrating on what we do best providing flexible family based quality childcare for 0 - 4 year olds.

## Grafton Childcare's Nursery Fees

Each September we review our childcare fees and decide if we intend to increase them or not with any increase usually commencing from the 1st October to coincide with any increase in the National Minimum Wage, increases in Energy Costs, Business Rates etc each year.

We are sure that you will be pleased to know that this year we have decided to keep our hourly rate fixed at £4.10 per hour until the 30th September 2014 when we shall review our Nursery fees again. Our fees compare very favourably with other high quality local settings, in fact we are cheaper than all of them. We only charge an all inclusive £4.10 per hour. But remember this is inclusive of our own washable nappies & freshly prepared home cooked meals, baby milk, milk and snacks, as well as all trips.

Adult to Child Ratios - 0-2 years maximum of 1:3 children, 2-3 years maximum of 1:4 children, 3-4 years 1:8 or 1:13 children when our qualified teacher is in ratio. When on local outings and trips we operate considerably higher ratios than the minimum ratios as stated above.

### Grafton's Nappy Changing Procedures

Please remember we leave your child in their disposable nappy if clean when they first arrive and will then only later when it needs changing begin to use our washables. This will mean that parents need to keep us supplied with 6-10 nappies at a time which we shall store here in your child's cubbies and not in your bags as previously. **Please could you ensure that you pop 6-10 disposable nappies into your child's bag next week**, we shall remove them and pop them straight into your child's cubbies and circle **Nappies** in your child's Daily Dairy or Communication Booklet when we need some more. We only use washable nappies here and should you not keep us stocked up with disposable nappies to use when your child leaves at the end of the day, we will have to send your child home in one of our washable nappies. Please wash it before you return it, thank you.
